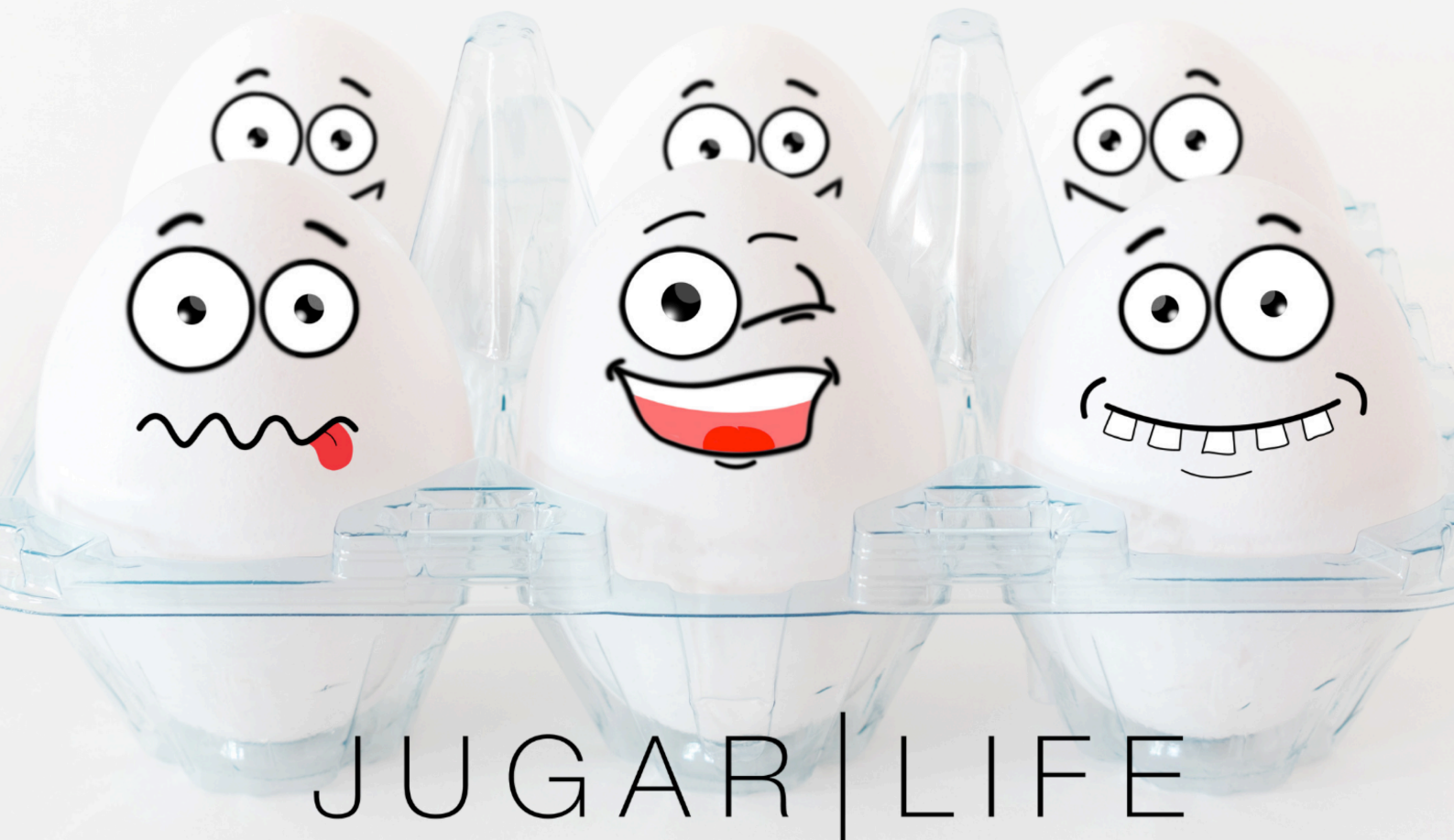


FAST & FUN FAMOUS *Faces*

FAST & FUN FAMOUS FACES

INSTRUCTIONS

This three-round partner game is the ultimate game for just about any situation. Taking a couple of classic games in famous faces, guess who and charades and mixing them to create a masterpiece.

This game works best in groups of eight, making four pairs that will all play against each other in three different rounds.

Before starting, each player must write down three famous people's names on pieces of paper that will make up the total of the 24 characters in the game. These can be anyone you like. Once all players have written three different names, the pieces of paper are individually scrunched up and placed in a bowl or a hat to start the game.

Each round is played for 30 seconds per pair, with one person doing the reading or acting and the other player doing the guessing. The players who have a great memory and can remember the different famous faces' names from their round and turn and the other players will do very well in this game.

Round one is where the partner can say anything about the famous name and use as many words and actions as they like, but they can't say the famous face's name or nickname. They can say everything else. Each time their partner guess's one correct, they get one point for their team. At the end of the 30 seconds, add up how many total they guessed right. The names they pulled out of the bowl stay out until each team has had a go, and then they are all placed back in the bowl for round two.

In round two, each pair swaps roles, the guesser is now the actor, and the actor is now the guesser. For this round, players cannot use any words. Instead, they must act out each name they pick from the bowl. Then, at the end of the 30 seconds, add how many titles each pair can correctly guess.

In the final round, players swap roles again. In round three, the partner picking the names from the bowl can only say one word about the famous face. Hence, we mentioned above that it is essential to listen to and remember as many of the 24 famous faces as this round is tough. Again at the end of the round, record how many correct guesses each team could name.

The winning team is the team with the most points.

This game can be used for any topics or subjects you teach. Use the same game mechanics mentioned above but change the topic from famous faces to muscles, bones, countries, foods, sports, you name it. This is a brilliant way to learn, revise and have fun simultaneously.
